Pre-K and Kindergarten:

Early Elementary:

Bible Verse Memorization

Psalms 119:11 “Your word I have hidden in my **heart**, that I might not **sin** against You”

Proverbs 22:6 “**Train** up a **child** in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it”

Memorizing Bible verses are essential to our Christian Life. Why should you memorize Scripture? For these reasons: You are a disciple of Christ: to know the character of God; to have victory over sin; to overcome worry; for confidence in witnessing, it keeps you spiritually fit; and for the counsel and encouragement of others.

Tips for Memorizing Scripture

1. Read the Bible passage in context of each verse you choose to memorize.
2. Be sure to gain a clear understanding of the verse, Meditate and pray on the verse.
3. Read the verse through several times aloud and in a whisper.
4. Write the scripture and scripture and reference on an index/recipe cards and carry it with you.
5. Develop daily habits for verse memorization.
6. Write the verse out several times.
7. Look at the verse first thing in the morning and just before you go to bed.
8. Use spare moments during the day such as – when you walk, while or when you are stuck at a traffic light.
9. Practice the verse with another person.
10. Make it a goal to repeat each verse and reference word for word.
11. Make it a habit to carry the card with you.
12. Don’t get discouraged if you stop, start up again.
13. Review the verses you have memorized from time to time to refresh your memory.

You can do this with the help of the Holy Spirit!
